Executive Summary:

The report provided an update on the discussions between the APCC and ACPO to resolve differences identified at the start of this calendar year which resulted in a number of Police and Crime Commissioners withholding payment of subscriptions for 2013/14. It sought approval to pay the subscription for 2013/14 in accordance with the agreement reached between the parties in June 2013.

Commissioner Comments:

The Commissioner indicated that he supported the payment of the subscription fee as the Strategic Policing Requirement placed a responsibility on him to respond to national incidents and ACPO was fundamental to that and so it was wise to fund it until it was known what was happening with ACPO.

- (b) that a further report be submitted in connection with the proposed ACPO subscriptions for 2014/15
