Executive Summary:

The report submitted an application under the Voluntary (Enhanced) Redundancy Scheme for Humberside Police for consideration by the PCC.

Commissioner Comments:

The Commissioner considered the application taking into account the detailed reason as to why it was felt that it should be approved. He noted the particular circumstances and that the 12 month pay back period was a worst case scenario and that savings were likely to be achieved in a shorter timescale once a suitable Humberside police redeployee had been identified.

Decision:

That the application be approved at a cost of £21,263.69 (including VER payment, pension strain costs and salary until end date) with a pay back period of 12 months.
