Title: Child Sexual Exploitation Documentary

Executive Summary:

Earlier this year, following the successful Crimestoppers campaign in connection with Child Sexual Exploitation you were approached for and agreed to provide financial assistance for a TV documentary on the subject (DR2/2015 refers).

You agreed to pay 50% of the costs of the original estimated cost of the documentary £4,000 to Crimestoppers and to underwrite the balance of funding for the project. You subsequently agreed to make a further £4,250 available when it was found not to be possible to raise external funding (DR23/2015) refers.

Following discussions with the film producers, Eskimosoup, it is now suggested that the balance of costs should be paid direct to them and that you would obtain the rights for the film.

Commissioner's Comments:

The Commissioner indicated he had seen and been impressed by the documentary which was now being widely promoted, through schools and on social media, directly at the target audience and this complemented other CSE initiatives that he was supporting. He was therefore content to agree to the revised proposal.

Decision:

That DR 23/2015 be rescinded and the balance of the commissioning costs for the TV documentary on Child Sexual Exploitation in the sum of £4,250 be paid direct to Eskimosoup.
