Title: **POLICE FOUNDATION – DETAILED RESEARCH PROPOSITION**

Executive Summary:

The Police Foundation contacted the OPCC in November 2018 seeking support to undertake national research aimed at developing a clearer and deeper understanding of public attitudes towards policing priorities. The offer was to offer insights nationally, but also with a focus on the local picture.

This research is seen by the OPCC as complimentary to the changes being made locally in our move to look beyond standard opinion surveys.

Report submitted that details the full offer, which includes:

- A richer understanding of local residents' viewpoints and priorities.
- An insight into the kinds of things the public would priorities if they had more information.
- Research findings to help bridge the gap between public expectations and reality.
- Opportunities to explore specific local issues – including public expectations for call handling.
- The opportunity to contribute towards the national debate.

Decision:

The following decisions are requested from the PCC:

1. Agreement to participate in the research project.
2. Sign the funding agreement for £13,000 prior to fieldwork.
