Title: **Licence to Occupy Ferens Hall**

Executive Summary:

The Lawns student accommodation block of Ferens Hall and the open space surrounding it has been vacated and the Force have been in discussions with the University of Hull regarding the possibility of using the facilities for essential specialist operations training (firearms, dogs and public order).

The proposal is to enter into a licence agreement based on a peppercorn rent. Arrangements have been made to ensure that the site is fit for purpose following fire, water and safety and condition surveys.

The arrangement will be beneficial to the Force in avoiding the need to use alternative facilities out of Force, saving on travel costs and abstractions.

The proposed use will involve high visibility training in the public arena throughout the day and will help to address concerns from local residents over anti-social behaviour at the vacant site.

Approval is sought to enter into a licence to occupy Ferens Hall, for use in Special Operations training


