Executive Summary:

This paper outlines the case for open tender of the Independent Sexual Violence Advisor Service Humberside (ISVA). The Commissioner directly provides budget for the existing service, for delivery of interventions in respect of victims of sexual assault via the MOJ Victims grant.

The report proposes:

- Open tender, effective from October 2023 and includes an outline funding range;
- Outlines all costs associated with the current service and additional grants.
- A Humberside OPCC lead, in collaboration with key stakeholders
- Early engagement and design of specification collaboratively
- Co designed with lived experience

Tendering this service directly supports the Police and Crime Plan in delivering effective organisations, Engaged, Resilient, Inclusive and Safer Communities. Ultimately ensuring effective services for victims and the most vulnerable.

Decision:

That the request for tendering the ISVA for a minimum of 5 years from May 2024 to April 2029, inclusive of 2 break clauses and two extension periods, at a ceiling budget of £400,000 per annum, and a total cost of £2m be approved.
