Thank you for your Freedom of Information request dated 9 April 2013.

Please find below the information that you have requested:

There were 13 people working for Humberside Police Authority immediately before it was dissolved last year.

Because preparation for the transfer to the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner had been taking place since the beginning of 2012 all staff were working to the revised structure that was expected to be in place under the Commissioner. The attached organisation chart outlines that structure and includes salary/salary band information. The total annualised staff salary bill for the Police Authority as at 21 November 2012 was £664,105 (£526,979 pay, £48,570 national insurance and £88,547 superannuation).

The highest number of staff employed by the Police Authority was during 2009/10 when there were 16 members of staff. The staffing costs for that year were £650,000.

Including the Police and Crime Commissioner and the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner, there are now 15 people employed within the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (although the Commissioner is not technically an employee). The total estimated annual cost of staff salaries in the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner is £721,661 (£571,979 pay, £52,990 national insurance and £96,692 superannuation) plus the cost of the Police and Crime Commissioner at £75,000 per annum plus on costs.
