Thank you for your *email of 20 November* where you requested information about expenses claimed by the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside.

I can confirm that the information that you have requested is held by this office. Please find below our response to your questions as follows:

Under the Freedom of Information Act could you please provide me with information on how much the PCC claimed in expenses in the first 12 months of office – November 2012 to October 2013. Could the list please be broken down to include details on how much was claimed on travel, food, and accommodation? Could you also provide details on the PCC's mileage allowance?

The information that you are seeking is therefore exempt under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), because the information is accessible to you, as it is already in the public domain.

I hope you find this information helpful. If you think that we have not supplied information in accordance with our Publication Scheme or under general rights of access then you have the right to ask for an internal review. Any request for an internal review should be made within 30 days and addressed to:
