- 2. Broken down by year, please provide details of the types of sexual violence/ domestic violence programmes that were funded- e.g. refuge shelters, counselling, work with male perpetrators

Our records have been searched and our response is shown below.

Police and Crime Commissioners (PCCs) were not created until November 2012. Prior to 2013/14 PCCs did not receive money from the MoJ to support Victim Services. A grant was received in 2013/14 to prepare for the transfer of responsibilities for victims to PCCs with effect from 01.10.14. The funding in 2013/14 was spent on preparation costs and restorative justice with no contributions direct to support organisations. There is therefore no data to provide for 2009/10, 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/13, 2013/14.

Please find attached a spreadsheet that provides the remaining information requested. Please note that the figures represent the grant support provided directly by the PCC, they do not include such things as SARC services which are provided from the Force budget.

I hope you find this information useful.
