

## Draft Structure OPCC July 17

There are 17 staff employed directly by the Police and Crime Commissioner, 3 of these are part time. The apprenticeship post has been advertised but is currently vacant. There are a further 11 members of staff also employed directly by the Police and Crime Commissioner but who provide services to both the Commissioner and the Force, 5 of these are part time. The Commissioner meets the full cost of these.
