Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) – Request for Information (Our ref: FOI611)

I refer to your recent Freedom of Information request submitted to the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside originally on 22 April and re-submitted on 3 June, requesting details of the following:

“I’d be grateful if you could let me know by return of email whether the PCC received any benefits-in-kind as part of the role in the 2019-20 year, and if so what they were worth and whether provision of a car was part of this.”
