I refer to your recent Freedom of Information request submitted to the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside on 24 June 2021 as follows:

The details we require are:

- 1. Suppliers who applied for inclusion on each framework/contract and were successful & not successful at the PQQ & ITT stages
- 2. Actual spend on this contract/framework (and any sub lots), from the start of the contract to the current date
- 3. Start date & duration of framework/contract?
- 4. Could you please provide a copy of the service/product specification given to all bidders for when this contract was last advertised?
- 5. Is there an extension clause in the framework(s)/contract(s) and, if so, the duration of the extension?
- 6. Has a decision been made yet on whether the framework(s)/contract(s) are being either extended or renewed?
- 7. Who is the senior officer (outside of procurement) responsible for this contract?

In response to your request, I can advise that the following information is held by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside:

- 1. Blue Door (Rape Crisis) was successful at the Pre-Qualification Questions (PQQ) and Invitation to Tender (ITT) stage. Victim Support were successful at the PQQ stage but not the ITT stage.
- 2. Actual spend £257,075.
- 3. 2016-2019 plus extension periods with STA approach.
- 4. Copy attached.
- 5. No.
- 6. No, but commenced a process to make a decision.
- 7. Stew Atkinson, Humberside OPCC.
