Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) – Request for Information (Our ref: FOI572)

I refer to your recent Freedom of Information request submitted to the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside on 14/05/2021, requesting details of the following:

“all forms of qualitative and quantitative research you have undertaken (surveys, focus groups, depth interviews) that have focused on public or victim perceptions of policing generally or your force specifically, covering 2019 and 2020 calendar years.”

You subsequently clarified in your email dated 24/05/2021 ***“I would like to request simply a list of what has been done regarding this”***

In response to your request, I can advise you that the following information is held by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside:

- In November 2019 a structured survey was carried out for victims of crime on their experience of the Criminal Justice System. This was followed by qualitative research of a selected group which was carried out online.
- Rural Policing Partnership survey was carried out between December 2020 and February 2021. The purpose was to enable rural communities to have a voice in local policing priorities.
- Annual Precept Survey. Each year the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner consults with the public before raising the precept bill. This is an online survey.

In addition to the above, unstructured engagement is carried out with the public almost daily by our Police and Crime Commissioner and our 4 Engagement Officers via community meetings, calls and correspondence.
