

Dear , thank you for your request for information below.

I can confirm that we hold this information and our response is set out below.

1. How many members of OPCC staff are there of March 2015, and what is the current annual salary cost?

As of March 2015, there are 14 staff employed directly by the Police and Crime Commissioner, this includes the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner and one member of staff who is externally funded – in addition there is one vacancy and one member of staff seconded from the Force whose salary is split 50/50 between the Police and Crime Commissioner and the Force. In addition there are a further 10 members of staff also employed directly by the Police and Crime Commissioner but who provide services to both the Commissioner and to the Force. The Commissioner meets the full cost of these.

The annual salary cost (excluding the PCC and on-costs but including the 50% funding for the Force secondee) is £855,036.

2. How many people working in your office are seconded from the local police force, rather than being on the OPCC's books, and what is the cost of their salaries?

There is one member of staff who is seconded from the Force, however, the Commissioner meets 50% of the salary cost and that amount is included in the annual salary cost shown at 1. above.

3. Please state the rank of these workers and what their seconded role is, ie sergeant working as staff officer.

The member of staff seconded from the Force is a Chief Inspector and his role is Force Liaison Officer.

I hope you find this information helpful.
