Dear Mr , thank you for your Freedom of Information request in which you sought “copies of correspondence (including letters, emails, faxes and similar) between the Police and Crime Commissioner's office and the Home Office in the last six months (from October 1, 2014 onwards) that make reference to concerns about police budget cuts.”

Having searched our records, for the timescale that you have specified, I am afraid that our response must technically be that no information is held. However, you may be interested in the attached letters which are prior to 1 October 2014 but are relevant to your enquiry.

We would aim to complete an internal review within 20 working days.
