The programme has only commenced direct delivery in Q3. Having experienced challenges in recruitment, we are now fully recruited. Because of the recruitment challenges, the 1st phase of delivery has just commenced, and as such we have little to present by way of outcomes, impact or evaluation.

The evaluation doesn't commence until year 2 and will be appointed by the Home Office, fully independent. This will be made public on request, due to be completed by April 2025.
