HM Inspectorate of Constabulary and Fire & Rescue Services – Fraud: Time to Choose Thematic

I am writing to you with my comments on the above report, as required by Section 55 of the Police Act 1996. I welcome the report, which was published in April 2019.

I note the thematic report and the recommendations made by HMICFRS. In particular I note the two recommendations relating to chief constables, namely (i) ensuring local processes are in place to accurately and efficiently report fraud outcomes to the National Fraud Intelligence Bureau (NFIB), and (ii) the requirement to publish a force policy for responding to and investigating allegations of fraud.

I will work with the Chief Constable to ensure these recommendations are implemented through our existing assurance mechanisms and within the timescales outlined in the report.
