Safer Roads Humber is the regional road safety partnership for the Humber region. The partners work together to reduce the number of people killed and injured on our roads. Here are just a few highlights of the partnership's activities over the last few months and a look ahead to what is in the pipeline.

National Citizen Service (NCS)

During the summer months SRH engagement staff support the various NCS programmes running across the region. NCS is aimed at young people aged 15 – 17 year olds who undertake a three to four weeks programme which includes team building and a community based project. <https://www.ncsyes.co.uk/>



Highways England Open Day

The team supported the HE open day in Wakefield. The partnership has a close relationship with HE who manage the strategic road network in the region e.g. A63 / M62 / M180 etc.

Big Bang Doncaster

The team attended the Big Bang educational event in Doncaster. This event attracts a number of schools from the Northern Lincolnshire area.

Youth Justice Service

SRH delivers bespoke road safety presentations to all youth justice service clients.

North East Lincolnshire

- Mature Drivers' event, Grimsby – the mature drivers' event at the Fishing Heritage Centre was attended by 21 people of which the majority have opted to undertake the MOT driving assessment. The feedback from the event was very positive.
- Toll Bar Academy – all year 7 pupils have taken part in the SRH Safe 4 Life presentation which focuses on pedestrian, cycle and passenger safety.

East Riding of Yorkshire



- Mature drivers – during May the team presented the mature drivers presentation to the ERYC school crossing patrol team and offered the MOT driving assessment.
- Cycle 4 Life week – the team supported the ERYC road safety team during their Cycle4Life week. This included a public event in Beverley, supporting the refugee cycle programme and the various school challenges.
- Shows – during June the team also attended the Race The Wave event at

Bridlington, the East Coast Classic Car run at Sewerby, Wetwang Scarecrow Festival and the Little Weighton Steam Fair.

North Lincolnshire

- Shows - the team have been very busy at events in North Lincs during June. This included the Messingham Show, the motor show at Normanby Hall, Scunthorpe Armed Forces Day and the 999 Emergency Service Day at Stantoft airfield.
- Fredrick Gough School – the team have presented to a range of students at the school focussing on pedestrian, cycle and passenger safety.



Hull

- Kid Alert – the team completed a two week programme working closely with Hull CC at their Kid Alert event. Over 1,000 primary school children attended the event and learnt about the importance of wearing a seat belt.
- Prison Me No Way – the team supports this regional initiative and undertakes the road safety element. In June they visited Winfred Holtby School.

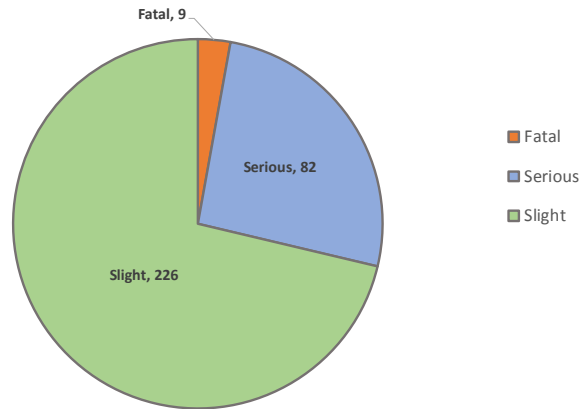

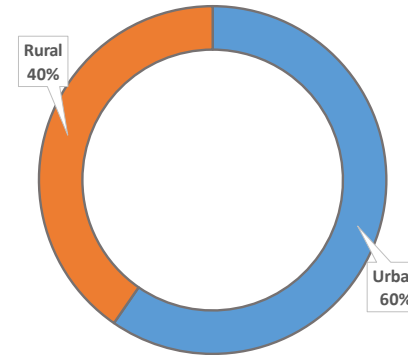

Jan - June 2019*



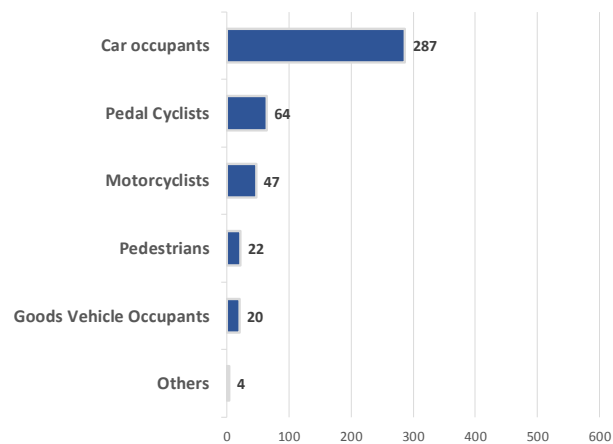

Jan - June 2019*



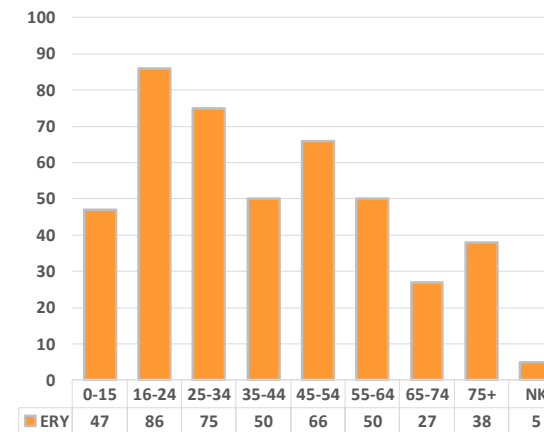

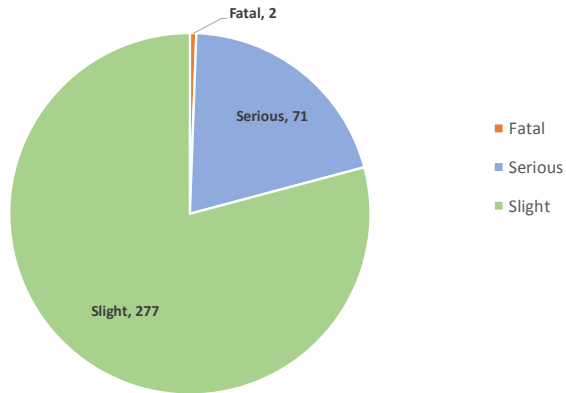

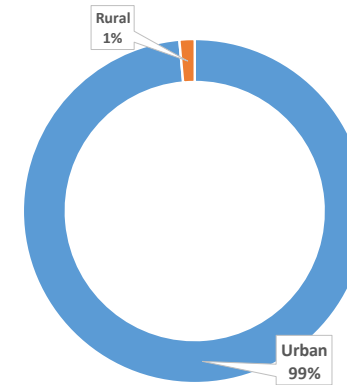

Jan - June 2019*



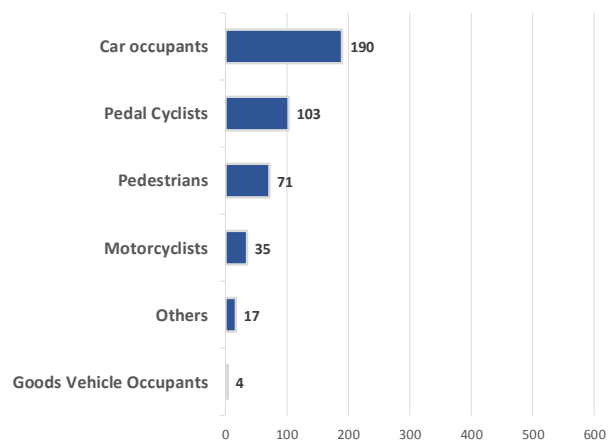

Jan - June 2019*



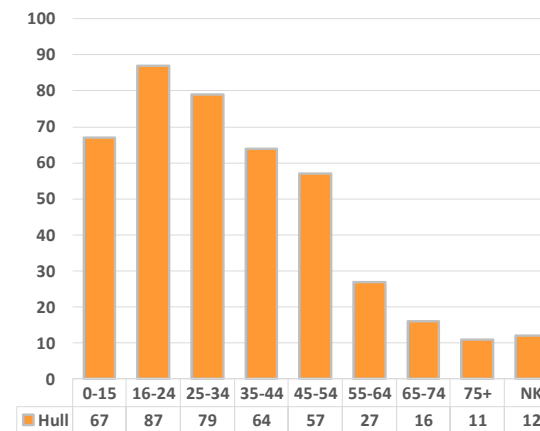

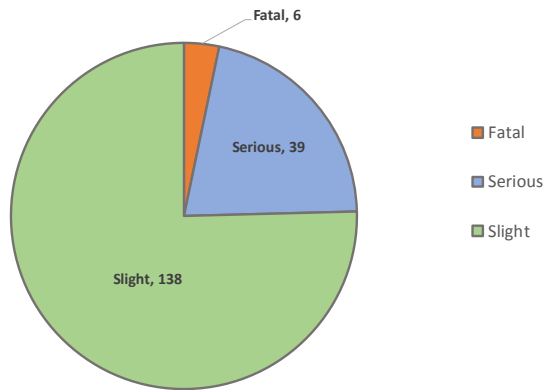

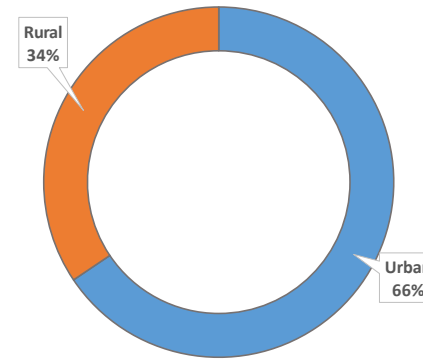

Jan - June 2019*



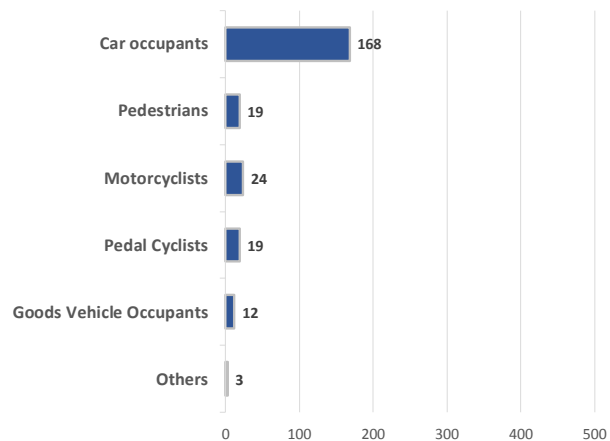

Jan - June 2019*



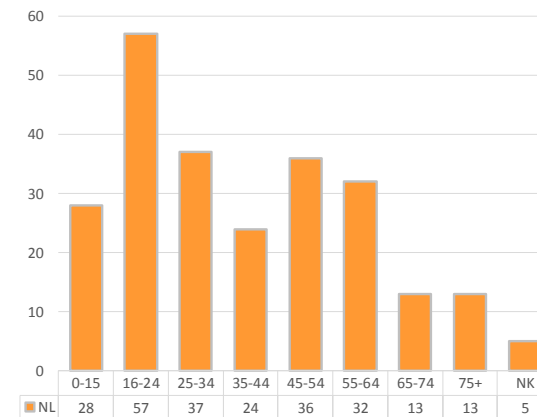

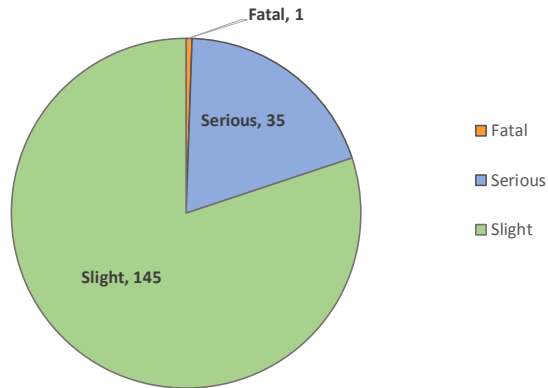

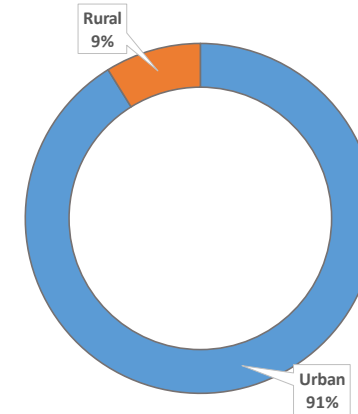

Jan - June 2019*



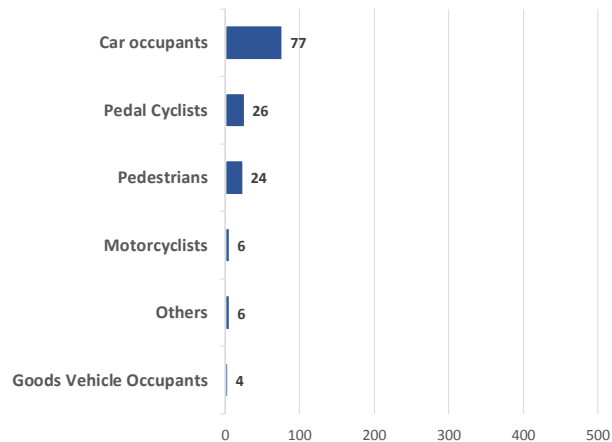
