## **Executive Summary:**

Responsibility for the commissioning of services for victims of crime transfers from the Ministry of Justice to the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside from 1 October 2014 along with a budget for provision of those services. The allocated budget in respect of Restorative Justice Services is £308k for the period 1 October 2014 to 31 March 2016.

The report outlined the procurement procedures followed.

## Decision:

That the recommendation of the evaluation panel, who concluded that the highest scoring bidder, Remedi, gave assurances throughout their bid submission in terms of their experience and capability and their professionalism, be agreed and the contract for the provision of Restorative Justice Services be awarded to Remedi at a cost of £307.950.
