## **Executive Summary:**

The report presented a series of recommendations following evaluation of the applications against the money available in the 2013/14 Capacity and Capability Fund for victims' services and the 2014/15 Victims Services Fund.

## Decision:

(a) That, following assessment of the bids against the agreed criteria, the following funding be approved: (i) Humberside Young Witness Service - £24,382; (ii) Vanel – Victims Champion - £15,000; (iii) Safeguarding Children (Anlaby Suite) - £569; (iv) Survivors - £11,280; (v) Women's Aid - £8,909; (vi) Probe (Hull) - £20,200; (vii) Cornerhouse - £7,236; (viii) Hull Rape Crisis - £9,300; (ix) Vanel – RJ - £9,750; (x) Therapy Services - £16,560; (xi) Safeguarding Children (Anlaby Suite) - £20,000; (xii) The Warren - £6,021.36, and (xiii) It's My Right - £41,500; (b) that the applications from NEL Safer Homes Services, Together Women and HANA be referred to the Deputy Commissioner and the Deputy Chief Executive and Treasurer for further consideration, and (c) that those applications recommended not for approval be declined but, where appropriate, letters outlining where the bid has failed be sent and they be encouraged to resubmit.
