Title: Relocation of Immingham Police Station

Executive Summary:

The new operating model, together with the estate rationalisation programme and a desire to work collaboratively has led to Humberside Police actively seeking to work in partnership. The proposed relocation of the existing police station will enable the Community Command team operating out of Immingham to work out of a shared modern facility located in the heart of the town, co-located with the Immingham Town Council and other public services.

Decision:

(a) That the lease to occupy accommodation within the Immingham Hub be approved; (b) that the expenditure of £23,000 for capital works to adapt the accommodation to meet operational needs be agreed; (c) that the marketing and disposal of the current Immingham PS following occupation of the Immingham Hub accommodation be agreed, and (d) that the property be placed on the open market, with associated sales expenses and the adaptations to the new accommodation being met from the capital receipt.
