Title: Loss of Protected Pension Age

Executive Summary:

To consider a request to accept at Part 36 offer from solicitors acting on behalf of police officers who retired before their 55th birthday, returned to work within the month as police staff and have now been told by HMRC that their pension payments are effectively at what is known as "unauthorised" payments, and that they will be obliged to pay a surcharge on them.

Decision:

That the Part 36 offer received from the solicitors acting for those whose pensions have been classed as "unauthorised payments" be rejected.
