Title: **Body Worn Video**

Executive Summary: In principle agreement was given at the Corporate Governance Group in July 2017 to the implementation of Body Worn Video across the Force, subject to consideration of the final business case which provides the basis for this report. The outline costs set out in the initial business case have been reviewed and updated and details of the latest estimates of the capital and revenue implications in 2017/18 and later years have been reassessed. A decision was taken on 4 August 2017 to purchase the cameras and software in order to secure substantial discounts and other benefits. This report seeks agreement to implement Body Worn Video, approval to make the necessary financing adjustments to the capital programme and revenue budget in 2017/18 as part of the Mid-Year Resource Review and to incorporate the financial implications for future years into the Medium Term Resource Strategy 2018/19 – 2022/23.

Recommendation(s):

- a) That the proposals to implement Body Worn Video set out in this report be approved and
- b) That the capital and revenue implications, including proposed allocation from the Technology and Capability Reserve, be agreed and included in the Mid-Term Resource Review and in the Medium Term Resource Strategy 2018/19 – 2022/23.
