Title: Covalent Software Purchase

Executive Summary: The OPCC have undertaken research to identify a software package that will help more effectively manage assurance and holding the force to account as well as tracking progress against the Police and Crime Plan. The team have reviewed a variety of options before deciding on Covalent as a preferred option. Indicative costings are yet to be finalised however the expected one off purchase costs are not expected to exceed £25k including first year license costs with ongoing revenues of approx. £13k annually.

Decision: That Covalent be agreed to proceed to purchase with a view to implement operationally for new financial year at a first year cost of no more than £25k.
