Thank you for your email of 17 May where you requested information about various costs within the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside.

I can confirm that the information that you have requested is held by this office.

Please find below our response to your questions as follows:

- A. The cost of any photographs that have been taken of the PCC, DPPC or any other member of the OPCC

The only photographs that have been taken of the Commissioner, the Deputy Commissioner or member of staff have been done so in the course of visits to the community. The photographs have been taken by members of staff who have been in attendance at the visit for inclusion on the Commissioner's website. Nobody has attended for the specific purpose of taking photographs, it has been an ancillary activity, and all photographs have been taken digitally, consequently there has been no specific cost.

- B. The cost and details of any other photography that has been commissioned by the OPCC

Since November the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside has paid for photographs of a PCSO ceremony at a cost of £175 – this is to provide a photograph to each of the participants and was something that was started by the Police Authority. The OPCC has also paid £75 for a collage of photographs for the retiring Chief Constable.

- C. The cost of any clothes, make-up or haircut that have been designated as an expense associated with the role of PCC, DPCC or any other member of the OPCC

- D. The cost of any car park signage that has been made for members of the OPCC since 15 November 2012

- E. The detailed costs of any office door signs, office desk signs and any other signage or plaques that have been made for members of the OPCC since 15 November 2012

As a result of the change in organisation, the signs on the outside of the building and one internal door had to be changed from "Humberside Police Authority" to "Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside" at a cost of £285.
