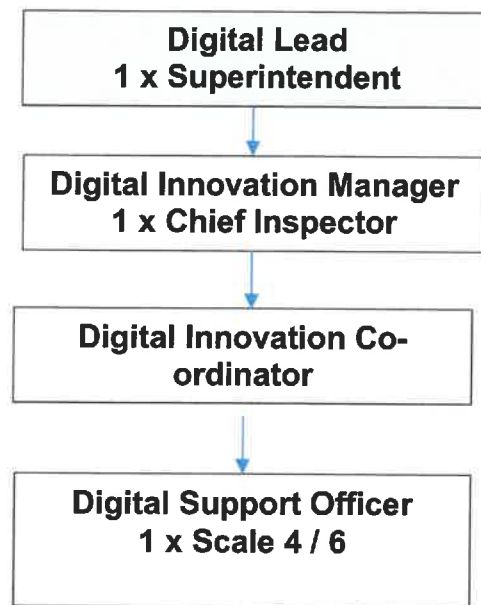

The additional funding current required to establish the Digital Innovation Team is £127,290. This will cover the costs of the Digital Innovation Manager and Digital Innovation Co-ordinator. The costs of the Digital Support Officer will be met from existing budget provision *from*
